Q: Will libraries have paper copies of the draft environmental impact statement (DEIS)?

A: Yes, all libraries listed in the DEIS notice of availability have paper copies as well as copies on CD and flash drive.

Q: What will the format be for the public meetings on the DEIS?

A: Each meeting will begin with an open house. During the open house, the public will have an opportunity to talk with State of Minnesota staff about the DEIS. After the open house there will a short presentation about the EIS and regulatory review process. Following the presentation there will an opportunity for citizens to make oral comments on the DEIS.
