## **Environmental Review & Permitting Process**

Certificate of Need (CN) and **Route Permit Applications** Accepted by the Commission



The Minnesota Department of Commerce (Commerce) is responsible for preparing an environmental impact statement (EIS) for the Line 3 project. Commerce is preparing the EIS in coordination with the Minnesota Department of Natural Resource (DNR) and the Minnesota Pollution Control Agency (MPCA).

To prepare the EIS, Commerce, DNR, and MPCA have solicited input from state and federal agencies, tribes, local units of government, and citizens. This input ensures that the EIS appropriately describes and analyzes the potential impacts of the Line 3 project and possible mitigation measures.

The EIS will be used to inform the decisions of the Minnesota Public Utilities Commission and other decision-makers regarding the project.
